
































The problems in our neighborhoods are bigger than any one person or church, and they seem to grow when churches compete and passionate people don't have an outlet to serve.

Compassion Connect helps churches and individuals unite to address two main community issues: health, through our Compassion Clinic and Compassion Care Center outreach models, and human trafficking, through our Adorned in Grace model. When multiple models are functioning in one region, it becomes an **Epicenter** of unity and compassion. **The Compassion Network** will aim to spark and support the growth of Epicenters in this next season.

We serve the whole person by addressing both physical and spiritual needs.



GRASSROOTS

Local volunteers are equipped and trained to own, lead, and manage the work in their community.





COMPASSION CLINICS

Uniting for Health

Millions of people in the United States continue to live without access to basic, affordable health care. Our solution is Compassion Clinics, which bring churches together to provide free health services to low income families and individuals as well as other extremely vulnerable populations.

Tens of thousands of people have received compassionate care and felt the love of Jesus over the years because of individuals and churches that have united together to host Compassion Clinics. Our dream is that the Compassion Network will help inspire even more communities to have the same impact.

It is estimated that hundreds of thousands of people in the United States are sexually exploited each year, many of them children. Adorned in Grace brings volunteers together from different churches to fight human trafficking by spreading awareness and raising funds through Adorned In Grace Bridal Shops, engaging in prevention efforts by mentoring at-risk girls through Adorned In Grace Design Studios, and helping bring restoration to trafficking survivors.

With the Compassion Network, we hope to mobilize more churches and individuals to provide hurting women and girls with the transformative love of Jesus.

Volunteer leaders in Queen Creek, AZ have hosted many Compassion Clinics since 2011 and have since launched a new collaborative service model called the Compassion Care Center. This community resource center is a gathering place for churches and service providers to meet, triage, and serve the physical, mental, and spiritual needs of the most marginalized people in the neighborhood.

The Care Center is a service model, like Compassion Clinics and Adorned In Grace, that we hope to equip countless more neighborhoods with through the Compassion Network.

Creating a Network and Stewarding a Movement

The Compassion Network is a step to grow and share our work that has been effective in the Pacific Northwest for the past ten years. It is a means of inspiring, equipping, and uniting more churches and

individuals to serve their communities and put their faith in action to accomplish the Lord's Prayer: "Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

PARTNERS

As we begin this journey, we will be seeking new church and community partners. Partners in the Compassion Network fall into one of two categories: implementers and epicenters.

IMPLEMENTERS

Communities that implement one Compassion Connect service model (such as Compassion Clinics, Adorned in Grace, or Compassion Care Centers). They receive resources and coaching from Compassion Connect.

EPICENTERS

Robust local expressions of Compassion Connect. They take on our name, provide local leadership, raise local funding, and are invested in spreading the growth of unity and compassion in their region. They benefit from shared services that Compassion Connect provides for a fee.



WE PROVIDE PARTNERS:

- Connection to and influence in a larger global vision
- Training, coaching, and encouragement
- Implementation support, toolkits, and start up investment
- Back-office services for epicenters

Leaders in the Compassion Network will feel inspired, encouraged, and equipped. Church leaders will have and use powerful tools to engage directly in service to their communities.



25,000 PEOPLE RECEIVING CARE

Tens of thousands of people will receive compassionate health care that addresses their serious health needs. Hundreds of at-risk girls will not enter trafficking, and will have the support to break cycles of generational poverty & victimization.



VALUE OF CARE PROVIDED OVER THE NEXT THREE YEARS: 5 MILLION

JOIN THE MOVEMENT: Opportunities to Take Action

BUILD THE NATIONAL NETWORK: \$631,000 OVER 3 YEARS



COMPASSION NETWORK: TECHNOLOGY CENTER

Build a center of shared resources including technology, website, communications, resources, and accounting to benefit all Network Partners. This will reduce costs, ensure quality control, maximize all resources, and aid all epicenters in fundraising and administration. INVESTMENT: \$85,000 (3 years)



COMPASSION NETWORK: LEADERSHIP & STAFFING

Provide the leadership and essential staffing for the Compassion Network to inspire, educate, and motivate hundreds of churches and thousands of volunteers to serve their neighbors. This team will lead the mission and fundraising, and oversee the Compassion Network. INVESTMENT: \$396,000



COMPASSION NETWORK: IGNITE MATCHING FUND

You can help Ignite churches and volunteers in a new region to reach their neighbors. Funds will be used to provide start-up matching grants to assist new local efforts with basic staffing, obtaining needed medical and dental equipment and supplies, and serve those at risk for trafficking. INVESTMENT: \$150,000

LAUNCH A COMPLETE EPICENTER: \$485,000 OVER 3 YEARS

You can help launch a complete local epicenter. Your giving will empower hundreds of churches and thousands of volunteers unite in service to their neighbors through free health clinics (Compassion Clinics) and anti-trafficking efforts (Adorned In Grace). INVESTMENT: \$485,000



LAUNCH PART OF AN EPICENTER: COMPASSION CLINICS

Equip a local community to bring vital medical and dental care to the uninsured and underinsured. Thousands of medical and dental volunteers will bring hope and healing to over 25,000 people. INVESTMENT: \$200,000 (\$100k in medical & dental equipment)



LAUNCH PART OF AN EPICENTER: ADORNED IN GRACE DESIGN STUDIOS

Help a local community fight sex trafficking. The future of young women who are highly at-risk of trafficking because of generational poverty, broken families, and abuse can be changed for eternity. These girls will have the loving support and care of mentors and receive vital education and life skills, empowering them to be successful youth and adults instead of victims. INVESTMENT: \$135,000



LAUNCH PART OF AN EPICENTER: ADORNED IN GRACE BRIDAL SHOPS

Help fund one or more Bridal Shops that sell bridal gowns and provide sustainable income for Adorned in Grace's anti-trafficking work. Bridal Shops produce from \$100,000 to \$200,000 per year in sustainable income. INVESTMENT: \$150,000
