TOTAL VALUE OF IMPACT

In 2019, churches from 26 communities in 4 states and 2 countries came together to serve their neighborhoods through our community health and anti-trafficking service models. That represents 3,513 people putting their faith in action and loving their neighbors as Jesus would!

CHURCHES UNITING TO PROVIDE

Our 2019 data shows that 88% of Compassion Clinic guests face at least one barrier to accessing important health services. It has also shown that the affluence of an area does not mean that the need is not there -it is often just hidden.

Many individuals and families are just one unfortunate incident away from having to decide between paying bills and tending to a pressing health concern. Not only did your support help provide physical services such as dental, medical, chiropractic, and vision, but you also gave out thousands of meals, prayers, conversations, connections, and other demonstrations of Jesus' love!

Your generosity in 2019 made it possible for a new Compassion Clinic to launch in Beaverton, and for churches in 15 neighborhoods to collaboratively provide health care to 4,486 people in 4 states and two countries.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION BEGINS WITH SOMETHING AS SIMPLE AS A RELATIONSHIP

UNITING THE CHURCH TO TAKE A STAND AGAINST SEXUAL EXPLOITATION

Our work has shown us that the Church and its people have an incredible opportunity to prevent human trafficking by mentoring youth who are often targeted by predators. Some factors that may put youth in harm's way for exploitation are poverty, foster care status, abuse, homelessness, and immigrant or refugee status.

The population of young people served by Adorned In Grace Design Studios faces these challenges and more, and it is our privilege to equip mentors from local churches to create safe spaces for girls and boys to build healthy relationships, learn the warning signs of trafficking, and gain personal safety and life skills. We have seen how this loving investment in youth helps empower them to believe in themselves and become advocates for others.

In 2019 your generosity helped sustain our work with current Design Studios and add three new Oregon locations: Beaverton, Milwaukie, and Oregon City! We believe that like Compassion Clinics, Design Studios are a model that can be used by churches anywhere to prevent trafficking and serve youth, and we are excited to see them continue to grow in 2020!
